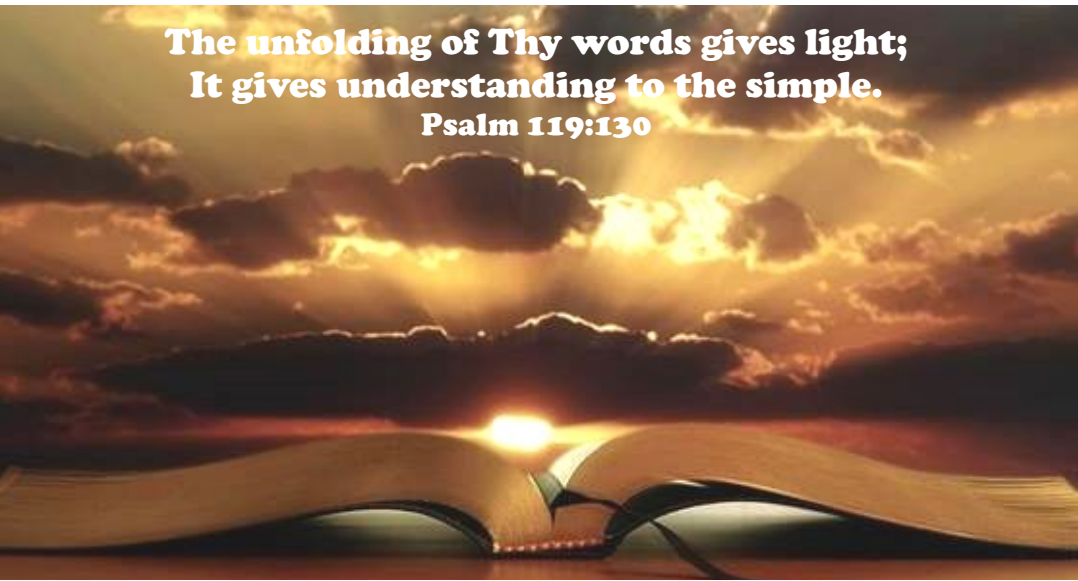

A FAITHFUL WORKER RETIRES Ivory B. Williams



The students, faculty, staff, and president of LABTS experienced a tremendous loss with the retirement of Ivory B. Williams on August 30, 2014. Ivory was a fixture at LABTS since he was hired in 2003.

Mr. Williams' relationship with the school began as a student in the Spring of 1991. He graduated in May 1995 after taking the following classes in order: John, Acts, NT Survey I, Hebrews, NT Survey II, Doctrine II, OT Survey I, OT Survey II, Doctrine III, Revelation I, Doctrine I, Manners and Customs of Bible Lands, Revelation II, Pastoral Theology I, Epistles of John, and Ephesians. Other classes were taken after graduation.

As a student, Ivory was observed on several occasions communicating with a fellow student, Sandra. God eventually joined them together as husband and wife.

God's providence led to a friendship between President Felix and Mr. Williams. It was initially a teacher-student relationship. Ivory took five different courses from Felix. He also was one of two students who completed a trial Beginning Greek course which was offered during the summer of 1996.

The friendship blossomed around their common interest in track and field. Felix and Williams' paths crossed at the Arcadia High School Invitational in 2000, after Felix had returned from Denver, Colorado. One of the runners Williams watched that evening was a ninth grader by the name of Allyson Felix. He has been a faithful supporter throughout her track career.

Ivory became an integral part of LABTS in 2003. His fingerprints have been all over the school. He served in the areas of Information Technology, media coordinator, student administration, photographer, etc. He will be sorely missed!
